

Ioannis Kampouris, Electrical Engineer, PhD

Director for Transmission System Planning /IPTO S.A.

Dr. Kampouris, was born in Athens - Greece, on November 9, 1962

He received the Diploma in Electrical and Computer Engineering on November 1985 by the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA). On June 1992 he received his PhD from the same school.

Ioannis Kampouris served in various positions: From September 1987 to June 1996 he was teaching and research assistant at NTUA, school of Electric Power Sector. From December 1991 to April 2001 he was working for Public Power Corporation as Engineer for System Studies Department. From September 2001 to May 2005 was Head of the System Development Studies Office in Hellenic Transmission System Operator SA (HTSO SA) and from May 2005 to September 2006 was Assistant Director for Transmission System Planning (HTSO S.A). From September 2006 he served as Director for Transmission System Planning until January 2012. From February 2012 to May 2015 was Director at the CEO office of the Independent Power Transmission System (IPTO S.A.) and from May 2015 until today he is Director for Transmission System Planning in the same company.

Ioannis Kampouris is a member of the Technical Chamber of Greece, member of the CIGRE Hellenic Committee since 1992, and since 2008, member of the BoD. Member of IEEE (Senior Member). He has served Entso-e from various positions (member of the System Development Committee and member of the Research and Development Committee, member of the Ten Year Network Development Planning Group, e-Highways Group and Convener of the South East European Continental Regional Group from 2009 up to 2016).

He is Author or co-author of more than 150 publications in international journals, national and international conferences.
