

Prof. Dr. -Ing. Athanassios Kelemis

Athanassios Kelemis, was born in 1959 in Katerini. After studying Informatics at the Technical University of Berlin, he obtained a PhD degree in mechanical engineering at the same University. Mr. Kelemis started his professional career in Germany at Berlins Technical University, as an Assistant Professor in the Computer Science. Later, he became a Consultant on Development Strategies of Computers at a banking sector.

He taught as a professor at the University of Berlin, at the University of Lübeck and at the Alexander Technological Educational Institute of Thessaloniki.

He was Deputy General Manager and later Managing Director at a private business organization and Developer of operational information systems in Germany for 9 years.

In 2002 he accepted the position of Director of the Department of Northern Greece of German-Hellenic Chamber of Commerce and Industry and at the same time, he was Representative of the Central Union of Chambers of Germany focusing at issues about transferring technology and knowledge on the environment and energy fields between Greece and Germany.

Mr. Kelemis is since October 2012 General Manager of the German-Hellenic Chamber of Industry and Commerce in Athens and since September 2013 he is a member of the Board of Directors.
