Alexander S. Kritikos is Research Director for Entrepreneurship at the German Institute for Economic Research, Professor for Industrial and Institutional Economics at the University of Potsdam, and Research Fellow of the Institute for the Study of Labor (IZA), Bonn.

Born in 1965, he studied economics and political sciences at the University of Munich where he received his degree as Diplom-Volkswirt.
