Costas Mitropoulos is an Executive Director of PwC Greece, since January 2013, responsible for developing the Advisory practice.

Costas has been, between July 2011 and August 2012, the Chief Executive Officer of Hellenic Republic Asset Development Fund, the Hellenic Republic's privatisation agency. He organised 18 transactions and completed three before resigning, raising €1.5 billion in total.

Costas was up to July 2011, the Executive Chairman of Eurobank EFG Equities, the leading investment banking firm in Greece, and the Head of Capital Markets of the Eurobank EFG Group with operations in Greece, Turkey, Romania, Bulgaria and Serbia. He completed numerous transactions and investments and has lifted the brokerage operations to No1 in Greece.

Costas was the founder, and up to 2008 the Executive Chairman of KANTOR Management Consultants S.A., a leading consultancy in Greece with offices in London, Brussels, Warsaw, Bucharest and Sofia. Previously, he worked as a management consultant with Coopers & Lybrand in the UK.

Costas is a mechanical and electrical engineer from the National Technical University of Athens, with post graduate studies in Business Administration and Economics, holding an MBA from Imperial College and a PhD from the London Business School.
